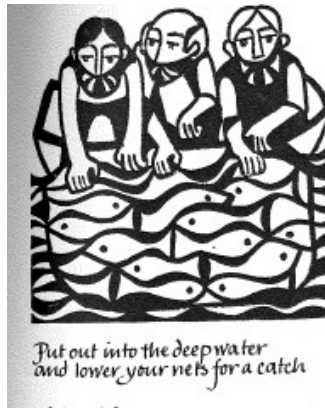

How are we attracting people to the church? Have you invited family and friends or neighbors to go to church with you for Mass or parish events. You too can be fishers of men.

Just a reminder!

- Our Cluster subsidizes tuition for our cluster parishioners who attend the Regina Catholic Education Center (K-12), Iowa City. With the subsidy, they pay regular parishioner tuition instead of non-parishioner tuition. Currently we have one student from Hills and two students from Nichols taking advantage of these subsidizes.
- The Gorman Seminary Scholarship provides up to \$40,000.00 for cluster parishioners who want to study for the priesthood for the Diocese of Davenport. After the first year of Seminary, the Annual Diocesan Appeal helps with the remaining costs.
- For St. Joseph parishioners, the parish provides scholarships of \$1500.00 to graduating high school if they go to a public or secular University or \$3,000.00 if they go to a Catholic University.
- Every parish can award a \$1,000.00 Menke parish scholarship to first year students to St. Ambrose University, Davenport.
