Minutes of the September 9, 2018 Pastoral & Finance Council Meeting were read and approved as presented. Motion made by Adam Gauger and seconded by Rose Harper.

Fr. Mike brought the following items to the attention of Council members: Joy of the Gospel meetings on Oct. 11 & 18 and final listening session with a diocesan representative on Oct. 25 at St. Joseph's hall in Hills and RCIA every Tuesday evening at Lone Tree parish hall. Religious Education continues every Wednesday.

This being a special meeting of Auction/Luncheon business, Kory Kaalberg passed out the solicitation assignments along with posters and letters of Federal ID number. This annual parish fundraiser is set for Sunday, November 4, 2018. All in attendance agreed to solicit their given assignments. Those not present will be given their sheets next Sunday.

As decided at an earlier meeting, the regular auction would be less items this year due to the generous monetary gift received from St. Joseph parish of Hills.

Yvonne Holcomb, Luncheon Chairperson, was present to discuss the luncheon part of the parish fundraiser. She recommended raising the price of the meal to \$12.00 which would include dessert and drink. She also recommended that the individual items of sandwich, soup and dessert be raised \$1.00 each. Discussion followed. Rose Harper made the motion to raise the prices as suggested and Ken Austin seconded. Motion carried. Carol Kaalberg will make new luncheon price sheets to post that day at the Hall. Yvonne asked Rose Harper to collect any money that might be given by parishioners to purchase food for the meal that day. Rose agreed to do as asked. Rose will keep track of the names and amounts so donors can be given credit on their annual church year-end report.

Members decided to have a meeting once again on Sunday, October 28 following Mass to finalize any other Auction business.
